The Contractor is hereby directed to return to the standard salary collections the amount of \$4,854,000 which represents .9% cost savings from the total authorized CY 2011 Compensation Increase Plan (CIP) amount of 2.9%. On April 12, 2011, the Department of Defense and Full-Year Continuing Appropriations Act, 2011 (Public Law 112-10, "Full-Year CR"), Section 1482, reduced the Department of Energy and the National Nuclear Security Administration budget accounts to reflect the cost savings resulting from the Contractor pay freeze instituted by the Secretary of Energy in December 2010. The authority to fund the site support projects specified under Modification 216 using salary freeze cost savings is hereby rescinded effective April 12, 2011. Any costs incurred shall be refunded and correctly charged in accordance with established and approved cost accounting standards and current terms and conditions as of April 12, 2011.
