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A. The following changes are hereby incorporated into the Contract:

1. Section I, updates FAR Clause 52.250-1 alt 1 to add the DOE Secretarial Determination dated March 26, 2020 related to COVID 19. This determination authorizing Departmental contracting officers to extend Public Law 85-804 indemnification to contractors and their subcontractors engaged in tasks or activities directed or authorized by the Department of Energy (DOE), including the National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA), in response to COVID-19. As a result of this determination clause I-061 FAR 52.250-1 INDEMNIFICATION UNDER PUBLIC LAW 85-804 (APR 1984) ALTERNATE I (APR 1984) (DEVIATION) adds paragraph (m) as such;
 - (m) This clause provides indemnification for the participation in tasks or activities by the Contractor or its subcontractors on or after March 13, 2020 through June 30, 2020 that is directed or authorized by the U.S. Department of Energy or the U.S. Department of Energy National Nuclear Security Administration, including work for others, as an element of activities taken now and through June 30, 2020 in response to COVID-19, including but not limited to efforts to test for the presence of COVID-19, to provide equipment and resources to address COVID-19, and to develop treatments and vaccines for COVID-19, to the extent the task or activity is not exempt from liability under the Public Readiness and Emergency Preparedness Act (PREP Act) or other law, or the exemption under the PREP Act or other law is limited in scope or amount which is not sufficient to provide complete protection against the liability to which the contractor is exposed.
