A. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this modification is to Update Part I, Section H Clauses H-6, H-8, H-15, and H-33; Update Part III, Section J, Appendix D with personnel changes; Update Part III, Section J, Appendix G to add three Physical Security guides; Update Part III, Section J, Appendix P to incorporate the new Construction Wage Determination.

B. CHANGES TO THE CONTRACT

As the result of this modification, the following changes are hereby incorporated into the Contract:

1. Update Part I, Section H with the following:

- a. Clause H-6 Parent Oversight Plan, paragraph (d), to add the actual costs for fiscal year 2025.
- b. Clause H-8 Utilization of Parent Organization, paragraph (b)(1), to add the actual costs for fiscal year 2025 and the estimated costs for fiscal year 2026 for organizational experts.
- c. Clause H-15 Performance Incentives, paragraph (c), has been updated to align with the CPEP deadlines for sites across the enterprise from:

The Contracting Officer will issue the Fee Determination Official's final total Performance Incentive Fee amount earned determination, and the basis of the Performance Incentive Fee determination, in accordance with: the schedule set forth in the Performance Evaluation Plan; or as otherwise set forth in this Contract. However, a determination must be made within seventy calendar days after the receipt by the Contracting Officer of the Contractor's self-assessment report, or a different date if the Contractor and Contracting Officer agree. If the Contracting Officer evaluates the Contractor's performance of specific requirements on their completion, the payment of any earned fee amount must be made on or before December 15 each year (or such other time period as mutually agreed to between the Contracting Officer and the Contractor) after such completion. If the determination is delayed beyond that date, the Contractor shall be entitled to interest on the determined total available fee amount earned at the rate established by the Secretary of the Treasury under section 12 of the Contract Disputes Act of 1978 (41 U.S.C. 611) that is in effect on the payment date. This rate is referred to as the "Renegotiation Board Interest Rate," and is published in the Federal Register semiannually on or about January 1 and July 1. The interest on any late total available fee amount earned determination will accrue daily and be compounded in 30-day increments inclusive from the first day after the schedule determination date through the actual date the determination is issued. That is, interest accrued at the end of any 30-day period will be added to the determined amount of fee earned and be subject to interest if not paid in the succeeding 30- day period.

However, a determination must be made within seventy calendar days after the receipt by the Contracting Officer of the Contractor's self-assessment report, or a different date if the Contractor and Contracting Officer agree. If the Contracting Officer evaluates the Contractor's performance of specific requirements on their completion, the payment of any earned fee amount must be made on or before December 15 each year (or such other time period as mutually agreed to between the Contracting Officer and the Contractor) after such completion. If the determination is delayed beyond that date, the Contractor shall be entitled to interest on the determined total available fee amount earned at the rate established by the Secretary of the Treasury under

section 12 of the Contract Disputes Act of 1978 (41 U.S.C. 611) that is in effect on the payment date. This rate is referred to as the "Renegotiation Board Interest Rate," and is published in the Federal Register semiannually on or about January 1 and July 1. The interest on any late total available fee amount earned determination will accrue daily and be compounded in 30-day increments inclusive from the first day after the schedule determination date through the actual date the determination is issued. That is, interest accrued at the end of any 30-day period will be added to the determined amount of fee earned and be subject to interest if not paid in the succeeding 30- day period.

 - b. PSTSG-GR-005 Rev 1 Physical Security technical Standards Guide – Standard Design.
 - c. PSTSG-TK-004 Rev 1 Physical Security technical Standards Guide – Test, Evaluation, and Qualifications.
 4. Update Part III, Section J, Appendix P, Construction Wage Determination, with Wage Determination CA20250018.
